FIRST COASTAL VOYAGE: M.V COSTA SERENA WELCOMED AT MORMUGAO PORT AUTHORITY

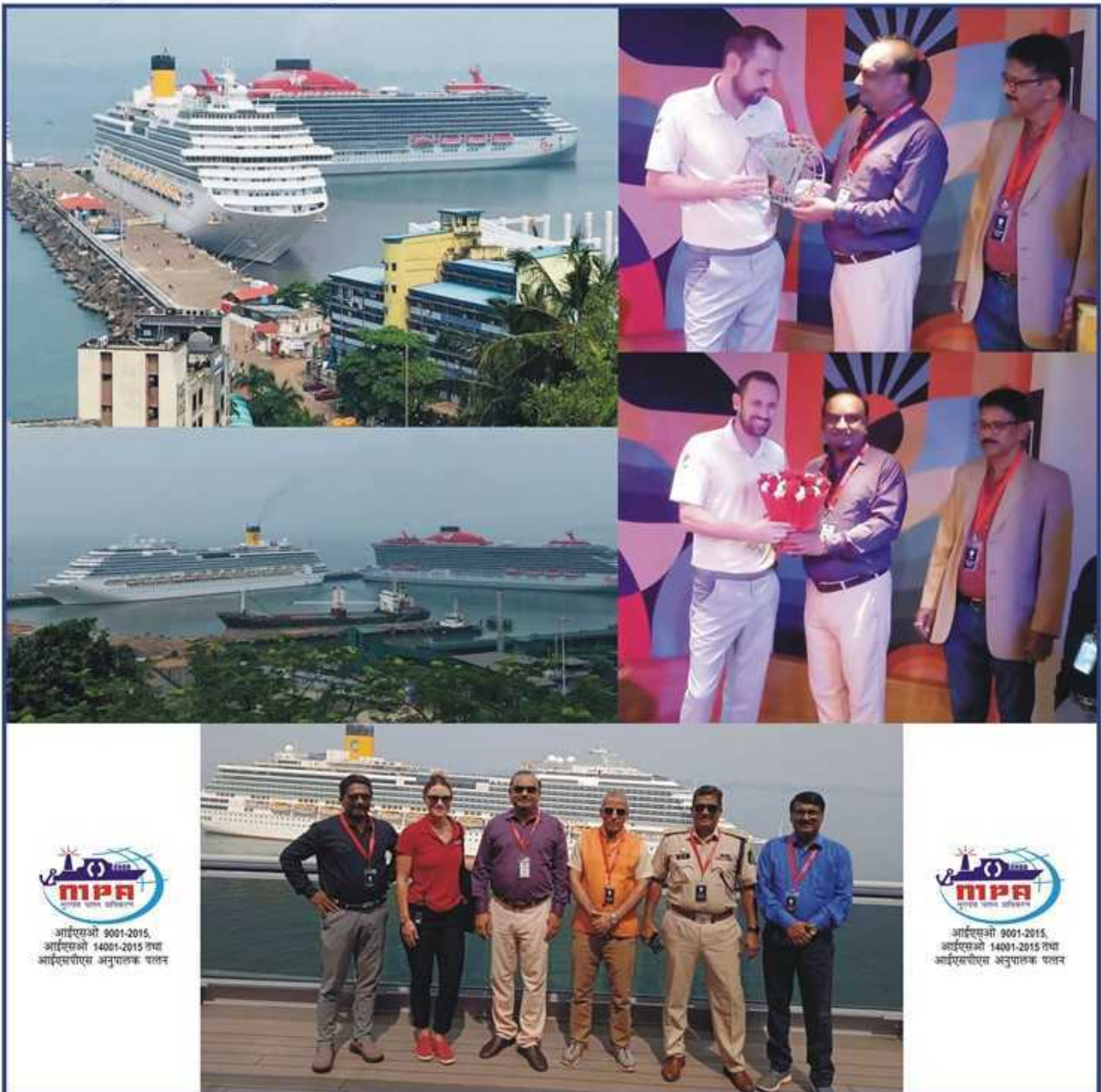
